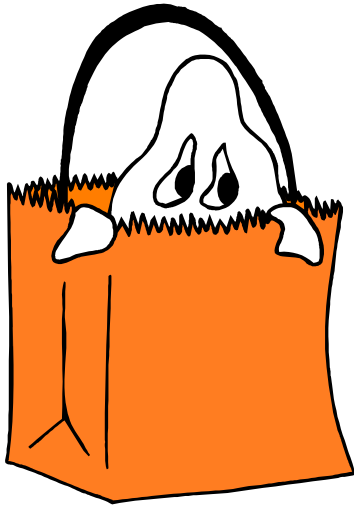

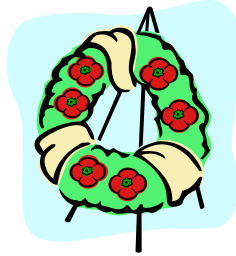
Zumba in the Port!
