**in the box to the right of the outside Community Centre building doors**

**Online Banking:** Sign into your bank, select manage/add payee, type in Port Williams, select a variation of Port Williams NS, Village - Water, then select continue. You will be prompted for a four digit account number which is listed below:

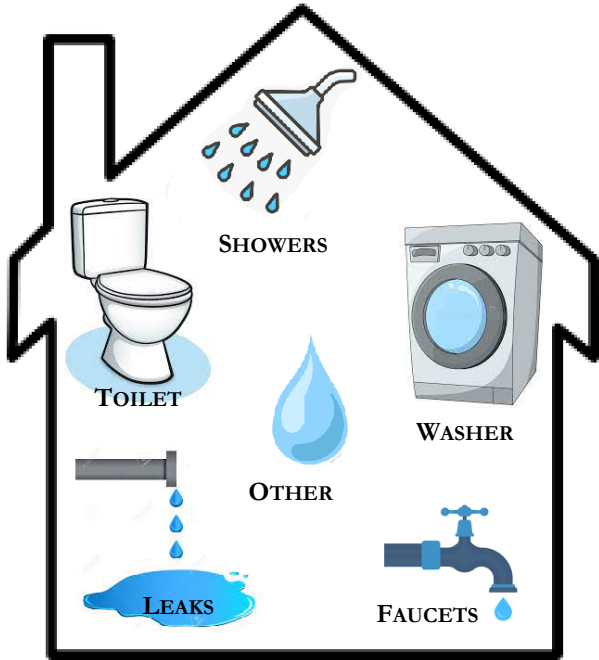

## Water Use It Wisely



### Reduce



- Changing water use habits and using energy efficient products can save you money!

### Repair

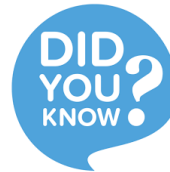


- Regularly check toilets, pipes, and faucets for leaks and repair immediately. One small leak can waste a huge amount of water over time!

### Retrofit



- Retrofit means adapting or replacing an old, water inefficient fixture or appliance with one of the many energy saving products now available!



- The Homeowner is responsible for service of the water lines from the water shut-off valve to their residence.
- Your sewage bill is based on your water consumption.
- Water meters are owned by the Village, but Homeowners are responsible for damage to the water meter.

## Water Rates

Rates are set by the Nova Scotia Water Utility and Review Board. On your water utility bill you will see a base rate and a consumption rate, among other details.

The Utility and Review Board approved the following rates:

### Base Rate for Water Meters

5/8 "	\$60.61
3/4 "	\$89.38
1"	\$146.91
1 1/2"	\$290.73
2"	\$463.32
3"	\$923.56
4"	\$1,441.33

### Consumption Water Rate

\$0.94 per cubic meter
